2. Call the legislative hotline at 1-800-372-7181 and leave a message with your representative and senator. Tell them to co-sponsor House Bill 162 and Senate Bill 102 because a scholarship tax credit program provides educational opportunities for all Kentucky students.

This legislation will support expanding educational opportunities for all Kentucky students with a Scholarship Tax Credit program. This program will benefit low and middle income families and families with developmentally disabled children. Under this program, individuals and businesses donate to scholarship granting organizations and in return receive a non-refundable tax credit.
