Additional Mass & change to Mass Schedule – Beginning Monday, May 22, 2017, we will add a Mass on Wednesday evenings at 6 pm, and move the Thursday Mass to 9 am. This will be a permanent change to the Mass Schedule. The Weekend Mass Schedule will not change except for the addition of a monthly First Saturday Mass.
