**Our 11<sup>th</sup> Annual Spring Festival will be NEXT Sunday, May 21<sup>st</sup> in the Parish Life Center from 12:15 to 3:30 p.m.**

- Our major fund raiser is our raffle for \$5,000. There are only 300 tickets for this raffle at \$50 each. When all the tickets are sold, the parish makes a profit of \$10,000. These raffle tickets will be on sale every weekend at the doors of the church. **So far we have sold 183 of these tickets! We really need to sell the remaining 117!**
