75th Annual Regional Corpus Christi Procession – NEXT Sunday, June 18th, St. Martin of Tours Parish in Flaherty will host the Regional Traditional Corpus Christi Procession. Eucharistic Adoration will start right after the 9 a.m. Mass and last until the start of the Procession, which is at 3 p.m. Bring your family and join the Clergy of our Region in representing our parish in this public display of our faith in Jesus' Real Presence in the Blessed Sacrament. There will be hymns and the rosary recited as the Procession goes from the church, through St. Martin of Tours cemetery, and ends at the Altar in the Cemetery.
