The Paragons:

Creativity Paragon- The Creativity Paragon uses their innovative right-sided brains to create fun-filled events for the Youth to enjoy. They will think of ideas (such as going to the zoo, hikes, and having open gym) that are fun and the ideas for the more religious side (such as going to the abortion clinic or having a day for Confession).

- This paragon consists of all the Youth members

Logistic Paragon- The Logistic Paragon uses their reasonable left-sided brains to plan out and decide if the events that the Creativity Paragon thought of is reasonable. They manage the finances, checks weather patterns, and makes sure the ideas and events fit into everyone's' schedule, so the Youth can have the maximum attendance.

- This paragon will consist of the Youth designated by the Admin Voter Quota (AVQ)

Administrative Paragon- The Administrative Paragon uses both the innovative right side and the reasonable left side of their brain to put the ideas and events into action. They will have the final verdict on the events and will enforce them to the Youth.

- This paragon will consist of all the adults, leaders of the Youth Group, and any Youth members designated by the AVQ

Spiritual Paragon- The Spiritual Paragon uses the depths of their souls to come up with events containing spiritual background, (such as going to Adoration or having a day of Confession) that way not only are the youth having fun, but they are also learning more about their faith.

- This paragon will consist of all the adults, leaders of the Youth Group, and any Youth members designated by the AVQ

Fundraising:

To execute all the ideas, events, refurbishing (we will get to that), and trips, the Youth will need money. To get said money, fundraisers are of paramount importance to the Youth, which is why we have come up with a few ideas to get your mind thinking:

Bake Sales- The plan is to do at least 1-2 bake sales every month. Not only will we sell just baked goods, but we will also sell drinks (mainly lemonade).

Church/School Cleaning- The plan is to clean these areas at least once every other month (more or less often if so desired). With advancements in technology, we have discovered there are products to clean bricks, tiles, and the various grungy places that inhabit our church grounds. The Youth will help clean these areas with the payment of Father and others.

Youth Garden - This plan will be very experimental and will need all Youth on deck to make it happen. The plan is to make a Youth Garden in which we can grow flowers or crops. Towards the autumn season, the Youth will have a harvest festival where we will sell all our crops to the parishioners. We will also bring crops to the bake sales if some have already grown.

Youth Potluck- This plan includes the Youth cooking/baking/buying a bunch of food for the church to have a big dinner/lunch.

Spring Festival- The Youth will involve themselves in the Church Carnival. The Youth will help cook or serve food, make games, and possibly entertain the church with events like a dodgeball tournament or relay races.

Refurbishing:

Cleaning the Youth Group Room- As we mentioned earlier, the Youth Group room is old and has various discomforts and has very messy objects/rooms that need to be cleaned, (such as the refrigerator and the old bathroom) so we should get all the youth together and take a few days during summer break and clean the Youth Group Room.

Buying New Furniture/Decorating- Once we are done cleaning the Youth room, we would like to buy some new furniture, decorations, and possibly paint the walls. A bigger, future project is to

possibly replace the tile floor with wood possibly. Most the funding for these projects will be coming from the TOY budget from fundraisers.

The Treasury of Youth (TOY):

With the money from the fundraisers and other means, we will need to budget the money for the Youth (Logistic Paragon and Admin Paragon). The budgeting percentage is listed below:*

- Trips/Events: 40%
- Sports/Game Equipment: 30%
- Furniture/Decorations for Youth Room: 30%

***Categories and budget percentages can be adjusted accordingly to the needs of the Youth and the church.**

Calendar Fundamentals:

- A Youth Meeting on the first Sunday of every month to discuss issues, finances, events, everyone else's schedules, etc.
- At least **one** Open Gym every month
- At least **one** spiritual event(s) every month

Checks and Balances:

Creativity Paragon **checks** the Administrative Paragon with a **2/3 vote**- If 2/3 of the Youth votes for it, the idea/event is enforced, even if the Admin Paragon denies it

Logistic Paragon **checks** the Administrative Paragon by **calling law**- The Logistic Paragon can call out when the Admin Paragon is being unfair to the Youth group.

Administrative Paragon **balances** the Logistic Paragon by **appointments**- The Admin Paragon are the ones who control the Youth in the Logistic Paragon with the AVQ.

Logistic Paragon **checks** the Creativity Paragon by **ruling an idea/event unlogical**- The Logistic Paragon has the power to rule any idea/event unlogical.

Creativity Paragon **balances** the Logistic Paragon by **trial by reason**- If the Creativity Paragon can give the Logistic Paragon good reasons and evidence to support an idea/event, it can pass all the way to the Admin Paragon.

Spiritual Paragon **checks all paragons** with **Divine Ruling**- The Spiritual Paragon has the power to add any religious activity without contestment.

Paragon Power Sets:

Creativity Paragon Powers:

- Creates ideas and events
- Plans and decorates for events

Logistic Paragon Powers:

- Manage finances
- Can rule an idea/event unreasonable

Administrative Paragon Powers:

- Enforces ruling and law in Youth group
- Has final verdict on ideas/events

Spiritual Paragon Powers:

- Adds religious activity to each calendar
