75th Annual Regional Corpus Christi Procession –
THIS Sunday St. Martin of Tours Parish in Flaherty will host the Regional Traditional Corpus Christi Procession. Eucharistic Adoration will start right after the 9 a.m. Mass and last until the start of the Procession, which is at 3 p.m. Bring your family and join the Clergy of our Region in representing our parish in this public display of our faith in Jesus' Real Presence in the Blessed Sacrament. There will be hymns and the rosary recited as the Procession goes from the church, through St. Martin of Tours cemetery, and ends at the Altar in the Cemetery. There will be Scripture Readings, Homily (by Fr. Hopper), and Benediction. Bring your lawn chair if you need to sit at the conclusion of the procession!

Monday Mass Change – Fr. Hopper will be away for Clergy day, so our Monday daily Mass time will move to 9 am for this week only.

Eucharistic Adoration and Confessions have moved to Thursdays. Adoration begins just after the 9 a.m. Mass and goes until the end of Confessions. Confessions on Thursdays are from 6 – 8 pm.
