If you are interested in joining the Catholic Church, please contact our Director of Adult Faith Formation.

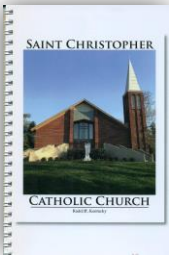
