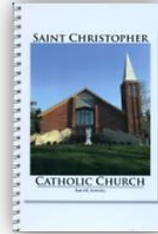


Photo make-up sessions will be held on:

What is RCIA?

The normal process by which an individual What is RCIA? The normal process by which an individual is received into the Catholic Faith is called the *Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults* or RCIA for short. During RCIA, participants journey with others (sponsors, team members, and parish representatives) towards the Sacraments of Initiation through individual study, lectures, group prayer, discussion, and service opportunities. Normally, most people are received into the Church at the Easter Vigil. Inquiry is underway. Please contact Glory Kramer for more information.

Sunday Morning Adult Faith Formation – the group will have completed 20 sessions of the outstanding program, *Symbolon*, with Dr. Sri; and will take a break for the month of August. Beginning September 10th, we'll embark on *The Great Adventure Bible Timeline* with Jeff Cavins. If you plan to participate, you will need a Catechism (CCC) and a Bible (preferably NRSV). The parish has a few copies of each for lending.
